

## Rules For Riding In The Mardi Gras Parades

1. You **MUST** have a photocopy of your Drivers License, Proof of Insurance & Your

**GWRRA Card (Up-to-Date). Scratch Out your Social Security Number on your Drivers License. YOU CAN'T RIDE WITH OUT THESE ITEMS!!! THEY MUST BE PRODUCED AT EACH PARADE!!!**

2. All Motorcycles **MUST** be **Water-Cooled**.

3. Entrants must observe all rules and regulations and follow all instructions from the Police or Parade Officials.

4. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden in the parade route or staging area by any participant.

5. No profanity or vulgarity is allowed along the parade route or within the staging area.

6. Parade participants may not accost parade spectators.

7. **ANY PROBLEMS WITH SPECTATORS, CALL THE POLICE IMMEDIATELY. LET THEM HANDLE THE PROBLEM, "NOT YOU"!!!**

8. Only forward movement maneuvers are permitted along the parade route unless approved by The Parade Committee before the beginning of the parade. All units are required to open or close the gap between the units when asked to do so by The Parade Officials or The Police.

9. **If you are not on time for pre-parade line-up positioning, you will be placed in the second to last position or anywhere the parade coordinator sees fit. No arguing or complaining about this or you will be asked to leave the parade.**

10. Clothing:

a. White Long-Sleeve Shirt

b. Black Pants

c. Black Vest (Chapter Vest Optional)

d. Black Boots

e. If Cold, Wear Warm Layers. Black or Mardi Gras Jacket/Coat Preferred, Not Mandatory.

f. Hat May Be Worn. Black or Mardi Gras Colors.

11. **No profanity or vulgarity while on You Or The Bike/Trailer.**

12. Your Motorcycle (and Trailer) **MUST BE CLEAN.** Decorations are optional: Mardi Gras or Red White & Blue Colors are preferred.

13. Trailers Can Be Used. You Will Be Put In the Middle Lane.

14. Helmets Are Not Needed During The Parade.

15. Children:

a. Children Are Allowed.

**b.** They Have The Same Dress Code.

**c.** You Must Show The Director or Assistant Director that the Child is Capable of Staying in their Seat. Binding May Be Used For Added Safety. (You are responsible for your own rider's safety. **GWRRA & CHAPTER LA K WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY!!**)

16. All Riders Are Asked To Attend The Riding Course On Parade Safety.

**17. Last & The Most Important Rule, HAVE FUN & BE SAFE!!!**
